

Fairest of the Fair Pageant

Rules and Regulations

Flaire Productions and the Western Idaho Fair reserve the right to change these rules at any time.

- **DEADLINE:** Application must be received by **August 9th, 2008** – If applications are not received in our office by the deadline, contestant will be required to pay their own entry into the Fair the day of competition.
- **The entry fee is \$30.00 for Miss and \$20 for Junior and Teen.** The first (15) fifteen qualified applicants to submit entries in each division will be accepted provided they meet eligibility requirements. Entry fee **MUST** accompany application for consideration. Contestants must be pre-registered and prepaid in order to compete. No refunds.
- Photo must be 4X6 or larger, preferably color, with no one else in the photo but the contestant. Animals are acceptable. Please make sure that the name and age of the contestant are on the reverse side of the photo. Photos will be returned the day of competition.
- Contestants must reside in Ada, Boise, or Canyon County.
- **MISS** contestant must at least 16 years old by August 16th, but not yet 21 years old, by August 31st to compete in the **MISS** division. **TEEN** division – contestant must be at least 13 years old and not yet 16 by date of competition. **JUNIOR** division – contestant must be at least 10 years old and not yet 13 by date of competition.
- Candidates under 18 years of age must have a legal guardian or parent's consent/signature.
- A contestant cannot qualify if she is or has been married, has a child, or has committed a felony.
- Miss Contestants will be judged on beauty, poise, and personality. Each contestant will compete in an on-stage interview (40%), fun fashion wear (20%), evening wear (15%) and on-stage question (15%), and photogenic (10%). Teen and Junior contestants will be judged in fun fashion wear (40%), on-stage questions (40%), and photogenic (20%).
- The winner of the contest will receive prizes as approved by the Committee, to include a cash prize to be determined before the application.
- The winner of the Miss division and her court will be required to make a variety of appearances throughout the remaining days of the Fair as designated by the committee and potential other appearances during the year. Junior and Teen winners may participate, but are not required.
- If in the Miss division the winner or any court member fail to uphold their duties during the Fair, or are caught in an act unbecoming a queen, they will be replaced and asked to return their sash, crown, and prizes.
- Each contestant will receive 1 pass for entry to the Fair the night of the competition (unless application is received after deadline). Family and friends will need to purchase their own entry.
